

**Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of Cononley Parish Council
held in Cononley Village Institute
on Monday 29th January 2018 at 19.00**

- 18.14 Present: Cllrs A. Parker (Chair), M. Lougee, N. Swain.
- 18.15 Apologies and reasons for absence were received and accepted from Cllrs H. Rudden, M. Allum and the Clerk, Mrs H. Gibbs.

- 18.17 It was resolved to make the following representations to Craven District Council on the new Draft Local Plan:

Clarification is sought for the following:

- (a) Page 57, Table 5 Summary of Housing Requirement and proposed Supply by Settlement-
- do the figures for Cononley include all planned builds, e.g. the Mill development?
- (b) Page 154, Table entitled "Draft Policy ENV10: Local Green Space" states Cononley - Local Green Space (LGS) sites assessed as part of Neighbourhood Plan preparation –
- is this statement a result of Cononley Parish Council progressing with its own Neighbourhood Plan?

(c), (d) and (e) below refer to the Appendix C under "Consultation Documents" accessed online from the link sent by the Clerk to the Councillors:

Clarification is sought for the following:

- (c) Page 59, section 13.5 Parks and Gardens Current Provision –
- why are Cononley Playing Field and Park excluded from this table (the Parish Council presumes that those listed in the draft Local Plan are publicly owned)?
- (d) Page 65, section 13.29 Allotments Current Provision –
- what do the "Poor" and "Average" scores represent on the Cononley Meadow Lane and 'Church Road' allotments respectively?
 - why are the Crosshills Road allotments are excluded from this table (again, the Parish Council presumes that those listed are publicly owned)?
 - Why are the allotments on Church Road referred to by this name? This is not a name the Parish Council is are familiar with and it is not a name in common usage within the village. It is assumed these are the allotments next to the primary school?
