

**Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of Cononley Parish Council Allotment
Committee**

**held on the Cononley Village Allotments
on Tuesday 18th September 2018 at 18.00**

No members of the public were in attendance.

- 18.17 Apologies were received and reasons for absence accepted from Cllr M. Allum.
- 18.18 There were no declarations of interest to receive or record.
- 18.19 An inspection of all the allotment plots was carried out.
- 18.20 Seven plots were found to be lacking in cultivation. The Clerk will write to the tenants concerned
- 18.21 It was resolved that the Clerk will write a letter to the hen and cockerel owners regarding the series of complaints received from local residents about the lack of sleep caused by cockerels crowing at unreasonably early hours in the morning.
- 18.22 Following on from complaints received concerning dead ducks on the allotments and an inspection of the plots concerned, the Parish Council was satisfied that the remaining ducks appear to be kept in reasonable conditions and therefore it was resolved to take no action at this time.
- 18.23 The Clerk will ask the Lengthman to have another look at the water pump.
- 18.24 A pane of glass in the greenhouse seems to have slipped down from its stays, which were still in situ, possibly in an effort to increase ventilation in the greenhouse this summer. It was resolved to leave this alone for the time being
